STAND ALONE - INDIVIDUAL PET PRACTICES & CLINICS

Facility Criteria:

- Minimum area of 200 sq. ft., managed by at least one registered veterinarian.
- Must have the capacity to provide basic treatment and clinical services (diagnostic equipment optional).

Structure: Sub-divided into Medicine, Surgery, and Gynaecology, each further divided into Canine and Feline species.



MULTISPECIALTY / CORPORATE SMALL ANIMAL CLINICS & HOSPITALS

Facility Criteria:

- Minimum area of 1,000 sq. ft., employing at least one M.V.Sc. degree holder with specialized experience.
- Outfitted with diagnostic imaging (X-ray, Ultrasound), blood analyzers, and inpatient care facilities. Includes corporate veterinary practices and referral centers.

Structure: Sub-divided into Medicine, Surgery, and Gynaecology, each further divided into Canine and Feline species.



ANIMAL WELFARE ORGANIZATIONS & TRUSTS (NGOS)

Facility Criteria:

- Any registered non-profit animal welfare organization, trust, or NGO actively involved in community animal healthcare.

Structure: Sub-divided into Medicine, Surgery, and Gynaecology, each further divided into Canine and Feline species.



POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Eligibility:

- Open to postgraduate students actively pursuing an M.V.Sc. degree in a registered veterinary college under a recognized veterinary university in India.

Structure: Sub-divided into Medicine, Surgery, and Gynaecology, each further divided into Canine and Feline species.



AVIAN & EXOTIC ANIMAL PRACTICE:

Scope:

- Covers clinical cases involving avian species and exotic animal pets.

Structure: Evaluated as a single unified category with no specialty or species sub-divisions.

Terms and conditions for CSAVA National Clinical Case Contest (CCC) 2026

ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION

Eligibility: Open exclusively to Small Animal Private Veterinary Practitioners and postgraduate students within India.

Qualifications: Participants must possess a minimum of a B.V.Sc. degree from a Veterinary Council of India (VCI) recognized university (proof required at registration).

Association Membership: Participants must be registered members of their regional veterinary association (proof required at registration).

Submission Limit: Each participant may register only once and present one case only.

Registration Fees:

- **CSAVA Members:** ₹2,500 (+18%GST)
- **Non-CSAVA Participant:** ₹5,000 (+18%GST)
- **PG Student:** ₹1,500 (+18%GST)

Registration Portal: Registrations must be completed online exclusively via www.csava.org

Payment Verification: Registration fees must be paid online, and proof of payment (screenshot) must be uploaded during registration.

Data Accuracy: Participants vouch that all information provided during registration is true, accurate, and complete.

Rule Acceptance: Contestants expressly accept all CSAVA regulations governing registration and event conduct.

Electronic Communication: By registering, participants consent to receiving official communications from CSAVA electronically.

RULES OF PRESENTATION & CASE AUTHENTICITY

Originality & Ownership: All case data - including diagnostic findings, imaging, therapeutics, and clinicopathological examinations - must be authentic, original, and conducted solely at the participant's respective practice or institution.

Plagiarism Policy: Cases must be entirely original. Submissions containing plagiarized material, unverified data, or copyright issues will be disqualified immediately.

Prior Exposure: Case presentations must not have been previously presented at CSAVA CCC 2025 or any earlier editions.

Species Scope: Presentations are strictly restricted to small animal clinical practice (Dogs, Cats, Avian, and Exotic pets).

Evaluation Focus: Preference and higher marks will be awarded for novel clinical insights, original concepts, and innovative diagnostic/management techniques.

Presentation Format: Each participant is allotted 8 minutes for a PowerPoint presentation, followed by a 2-minute discussion/Q&A session with the judging panel.

Presenter Substitution: The presenting author cannot be changed or substituted after abstract submission.

REFUNDS & EVENT ADMINISTRATION

Refund Policy: Registration fees are non-refundable and non-reimbursable, except in cases where an abstract is not selected for presentation by the CSAVA Board.

Judging Panel: CSAVA has appointed an impartial panel of specialized veterinary experts from across India to evaluate submissions without bias.

Travel & Accommodation: Participants are responsible for their own travel and lodging arrangements. Complimentary lunch, tea, and snacks will be provided at the venue.

Gala Dinner: Complimentary for all contest award winners. Available to other delegates at ₹3,500 per head.

CSAVA CCC COMMITTEE DISCRETION & AUTHORITY

Committee Authority: The CSAVA CCC Committee reserves all discretion to recognize or derecognize categories and sub-categories, regulate the number of entries, adjust presentation timings, switch participant categories, or increase/reduce awards and cash prizes based on minimal and maximal entry volumes received.

CSAVA PRIVACY POLICY
