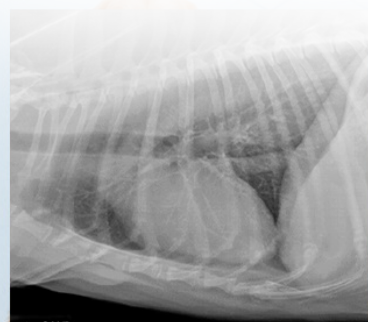

Dr. Steinhaus is a small animal internal medicine specialist and interventional radiology clinician based in Hong Kong. He is the CEO and CMO of Vetiva Center for Animal Wellness, an IRIS Ambassador to Hong Kong, and a Member of the Veterinary Surgeons Board (Hong Kong). With over a decade of specialty experience, he has held senior clinical roles in Hong Kong, the UK, and the USA, including an Interventional Radiology Fellowship at the Animal Medical Center, New York, and an Internal Medicine Residency in Connecticut.

A graduate of Murdoch University (BVMS), with biology degrees from Hofstra University and Franklin & Marshall College, Dr. Steinhaus also completed advanced training in hemodialysis at UC Davis. He maintains active affiliations with nephrology, interventional radiology, and feline medicine societies, and has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications and conference presentations.

Aurélie Lyssens graduated as a veterinarian from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Ghent University in 2018. She subsequently completed a rotating internship at Ghent University, followed by a specialized internship in small animal internal medicine at the University of Liège. In 2020, she began her residency in small animal internal medicine at the same institution and became a Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine – Companion Animals (ECVIM-CA) in 2024. Alongside her residency, she completed a PhD focusing on bronchiectasis and bronchomalacia in dogs, with particular emphasis on treatment strategies, the respiratory microbiome, and the role of neutrophil extracellular traps (NETs). Until recently, she worked as a senior clinician in the Small Animal Teaching Hospital at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Liège. She is now relocating to Sweden, where she will help establish and develop the internal medicine service in a private referral hospital.
